August 20 & 21, 2022



Group locations are further defined by letters designating each artist at the stop.

We have tried our best to guide you from place to place with detailed maps and written instructions, as well as road and location signs, but if you have any questions, or find yourself lost, please contact us:




# Roger Gateson Acrylic on Canvas
