The Boreal Shores Art Tour is a free, self-guided driving tour featuring individual artists studios and artist group locations throughout Eastern Manitoba. Divided into two colour-defined regions, the studios and group locations are indicated by coloured dots with stop numbers in them. Group locations are further defined by letters designating each artist at the stop.

The Tour is an adventure and, like any good adventure, presents a mixture of surprises and challenges. The locations are a combination of old and new, public and private spaces. Some are easy to get into  others have stairs . Some have washrooms available  others do not. (Wheelchair accessibility is varied, so please contact ahead for information.) We have tried our best to guide you from place to place with detailed maps and written instructions, as well as road and location signs.

The artists on the Tour are excited to welcome you to their creative spaces to view their work and learn about their creative processes. Discover a new piece of art for you or your home, and don't forget to check the ads in the brochure for a good place to stop and recharge! 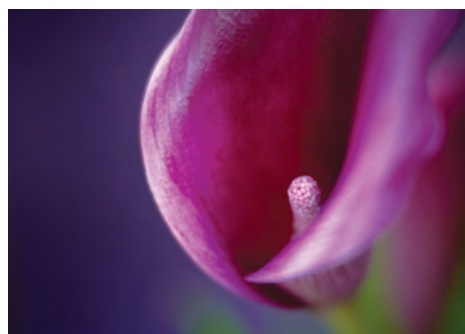

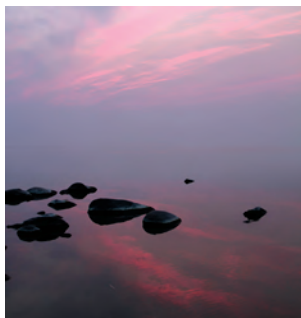

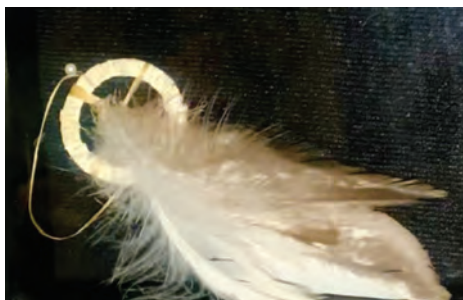

Deadline for applications for the 2025 Tour is January 31, 2025. We will accept applications at any point from now until then.

At the opening reception, held in 2017 to launch the Boreal Shores Art Tour, the attendees created a work of art at the party which was then auctioned off raising the initial funds for our "Artist Assistance Fund." This Fund is used to sponsor artists into the tour who cannot afford the fees themselves for various reasons. These can be young aspiring artists who show promise to the jury or established artists for whom life has not been kind. To apply, an artist need only address an email to the Board explaining their circumstances. We keep all information confidential, and recipients of the fund are not identified publicly.

In January 2020, the fund was renamed to the
Rosemary Scurfield Memorial Artist Assistance Fund
in memory of Rosemary Scurfield. Rosemary was a glass artist in the Boreal Shores Art Tour for 2017 and 2018. She was forced to withdraw in 2019 to fight cancer and passed away on Dec 27, 2019. She and her husband Bob were enthusiastic supporters of BSAT and contributed their time and financial support each year.
